


The Province of Iloilo occupies the southern and the northeastern portion of Panay Island. It is bounded by the Province of Capiz and Jintotolo Channel in the north; Panay Gulf and Iloilo Strait in the south; Visayan Sea and Guimaras Strait in the east; and the Province of Antique in the west.

Fig. 2: BOUNDARIES OF THE PROVINCE




Fig. 3: LAND USE STATUS: 2008

The Province of Iloilo is a first class province and is divided into **5 congressional districts**, composed of different municipalities as follows:




Fig. 4: CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS

C. TOPOGRAPHY

The topography of the Province of Iloilo varies from flat lands and rolling hills to mountain peaks and ranges. The mountain range lies along the border between Iloilo and the provinces of Antique and Capiz, and roll down into flat plains towards the coastal towns. Almost one-third of the entire province is considered flat.

D. CLIMATE RAINFALL

It is dry from December to June and wet from July to November along the southern-northern part of the province and portion of the central municipalities. There is no distinct wet and dry season in the Iloilo-Capiz border. The annual rainfall for 2017 is 2,197.9 mm. The minimum temperature is 24.6 °C and the maximum temperature is 30.6 °C for the year 2017.

E. SOIL

There are **seventeen types** of soil found in the province. Generally, the soil is fertile and suitable to almost all types of agricultural crops. The loam type of soil is predominant and conducive to farming.

F. WATER SOURCES

More than a hundred rivers and creeks traverse the entire province and these are identified as possible sources of irrigation water. The **Jalaur river basin** records the **highest annual flow** and is considered as the **major source of irrigation water**. The province has potential underground water supply, which is mostly tapped for domestic use.






Fig. 8: POPULATION BY MARITAL STATUS BY SEX: 2015 CENSUS




Fig. 9: FAMILY INCOME AND FAMILY EXPENDITURE BY INCOME CLASS: 2015




Fig. 10: RICE PRODUCTION: 2017




Fig. 11: CORN PRODUCTION: 2017

THE ILOILO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

The Iloilo International Airport is located in Brgy. Duyanduyan, Cabatuan, Iloilo with 2,500 m. x 45 m. runway and a new terminal building with state-of-the-art computerized facilities to accommodate flights from the North and South of the country. Stands as one of the busiest airports outside Manila, the new airport of international standard is built on a wider and panoramic location to cater the increasing influx of passengers visiting Iloilo.

The province's airport is one of the major airports of the country and serves as a jump off point to different provinces in Panay Island accommodating daily flights from Manila and Cebu. The New Iloilo Airport Terminal could now accommodate more passengers and cargoes. The 2,500 m. stretch of runway was overlaid with asphalt to accommodate heavier aircrafts with an adjacent runway strip of 2,620 m.

c.1.2) Iloilo Fish Port Complex (IFPC)

The Iloilo Fish Port Complex (IFPC) is the center of fish trading and marine products processing in Region VI. It was constructed to provide safe landing facilities for fishing vessels, reduce fish spoilage and prevent double handling of fish. IFPC is situated in a 21-hectare reclaimed area at Brgy. Tanza, Iloilo City. This strategic location has made the port the major fish source of Iloilo City's major public markets and adjacent municipalities.




Fig. 12: TOURIST ARRIVAL: 2017

f.11 Tourist Destinations

Visitors will never run out of options here, thanks to its exceptional range of different landscapes with just short distances away, lots of leisure activities and a unique cultural heritage where tradition and modernity blend together in perfect harmony. In addition to that, one thing that the whole of Iloilo offers is their hospitality.

There are a plethora of good accommodation options in the province. And if you do not mind living in budget accommodations, there are a number of places that you can visit without getting broke.

So, if you are looking for a perfect vacation destination, weekend getaway, or just a place to kick back and relax, Iloilo is the ideal place to visit. No matter what you choose to explore, IT'S GOT TO BE ILOILO.





First District: Heritage Destination

Iloilo is a diverse province steeped in history. Its past has seen a melting pot of different cultures which have left their mark in some towns. The best thing about traveling to Iloilo is exploring the history of its many towns. By doing so, it can help us understand how it became what it is today.

Southern Iloilo is also positioned as the HERITAGE DESTINATION of the province and many people visit the area every year to see its historic attractions. Belonging to the First Congressional District comprising the towns of Oton, Tigbauan, Guimbal, Tubungan, Igbaras, Miagao and San Joaquin, it is the fourth largest in terms of land area and population in the province.

The area is an irreplaceable outdoor museum that provides a beautiful backdrop of historic sites. In 1993 Miagao prides itself as the home of the only UNESCO World Heritage Site in the Visayas and Mindanao, the St. Thomas of Villanova Parish Church. It was declared as a National Shrine in 1973.

The picturesque southern mountain ranges and coastline in the area form a springboard for a different exploration. There are 42 accommodation establishments in the district offering 300 air-conditioned rooms and 92 fan rooms. The district is the second biggest contributor of tourist arrivals for the province with 27.43%.

To get to southern Iloilo, visitors can take a jeepney at Don Benito Q. Acap Sr. Southern Iloilo Perimeter Boundary Terminal in Barangay Mohon, Oton, Iloilo. Metered taxis are also available at the terminal. Visitors can also take a jeepney at the market terminal at the back of Robinsons Place Iloilo mall.

Second District: Eco-Cultural Destination

Ecotourism in Iloilo will keep visitors exploring forever. The Second Congressional District is positioned as the ECO-CULTURAL DESTINATION of the province and people visit the area every year to see its historic attractions. The district comprising the towns of Alimodian, Leganes, Leon, New Lucena, Pavia, San Miguel, Sta. Barbara and Zarraga. In the whole province, it is the smallest in terms of land area and population.

The area is blessed with an incredible landscape including vast rice fields, rugged mountains and lush forest. A visit to the district would not be complete without being amazed by magnificent natural beauty like Bucari of Leon and Seven Cities of Alimodian.

Practically every town from this district has its unique festival that offers a relatively pristine cultural experience to every visitor. Leading the pack is the provinces' oldest cultural celebration, Carabao-Carroza of Pavia.

There are 18 accommodation establishments in the district offering 173 air-conditioned rooms and 71 fan rooms. The district is the fourth biggest contributor of tourist arrivals for the province with 13.40%.

To get to the town of Leon, visitors can take a jeepney or van at Pavia People's Terminal in Barangay Ungka II, Pavia, Iloilo or at El 98 Street, Mandurria, Iloilo City. For visitors wanting to visit Alimodian, San Miguel and Leon, jeepneys are available at the Aleosan Transport Terminal in El 98 Street, Mandurria, Iloilo City or at Aleosan Transport Terminal in Barangay Hibao-an, Mandurria, Iloilo City. To get to Sta. Barbara and New Lucena, one can take a jeepney at Ungka Transport Terminal fronting Christ the King Memorial Park in Jaro, Iloilo City.



Third District: Eco-Agri Destination



The Third Congressional District is among the most rewarding travel destinations in the province of Iloilo. The area is known as the ECO-AGRI DESTINATION of the province made up of the towns of Cabatuan, Maasin, Janiuay, Badiangan, Lambunao, Calinog, Bingawan, Mina and Pototan. The district is the second largest in terms of land area and the most populated in the province.

With well-preserved colonial architecture, dramatic natural landscapes, vibrant indigenous community and with an extraordinary land where endangered fauna and unique flora reign supreme, the area packs its perimeters with more points of interest than its neighboring districts.

Visitors can indulge in a colourful adventure by exploring this territory filled with ecological and agricultural treasures. The area conceals many possibilities of adventures and discoveries and is home to a cordial and indigenous picturesque people with their unique story-telling technique, dance and colourful costumes can already say so much.

There are 20 accommodation establishments in the district offering 134 air-conditioned rooms and 44 fan rooms. The district is the third biggest contributor of tourist arrivals for the province with 15.69%.

To get to the towns of Cabatuan, Janiuay and Lambunao, visitors can take a jeepney or van at Ungka Transport Terminal fronting Christ the King Memorial Park in Barangay Ungka II, Pavia, Iloilo City. For the towns of Maasin, Lambunao and Calinog jeepneys are available the Pavia People's Terminal in Barangay Ungka II, Pavia, Iloilo.

Fourth District: Historical-Adventure Destination

Iloilo is awash in ancient history, scenic landscapes, beautiful culture, and non-stop fun. There are sides of the province perfect for every traveller like caves waiting to be explored and along the way, reminders our colonial past dot the landscape. For the adventurous in spirit, the time of your life awaits down here. All you have to do is find it.

The Fourth Congressional District is also known as the HISTORICAL-ADVENTURE DESTINATION of the province comprising the towns of Dumangas, Dingle, Duenas, Passi City, San Enrique, Barotac Nuevo, Anilao and Banate. It is the third largest in terms of land area and population in the province.

The area is also filled with mystery, tradition and outdoor adventures in abundance. There is so much to see from the windswept national parks of Bulabog Puti-an National Park in Dingle, not forgetting the city of Passi with 16 caves. Underwater lovers will also thrill at the diversity of corals in Hibotkan Rok Marine Sanctuary in Banate. Explore the colonial Spanish towns of Dumangas, Duenas and Barotac Nuevo.

There are 16 accommodation establishments in the district offering 100 air-conditioned rooms and 66 fan rooms. The district ranked the fifth biggest contributor of tourist arrivals for the province with 5.12%.

To get to Dumangas, visitors can take a van at Baldoza Transport Terminal at Zone 3, Barangay Baldoza, Lapaz, Iloilo City. For those going to Passi City, busses are available at North Central Iloilo Transport Terminal in Barangay Tagbak, Jaro, Iloilo City.





Fifth District: Resort Destination

Iloilo offers enchanted and preserved island beaches, a clean water and a guarantee of bright sun. Whether you seek shade, privacy or family-friendly spots, you will have plenty to choose from to go for a swim, build a sand castle or take an afternoon nap.

Northern Iloilo is also known as the RESORT DESTINATION of the province and many people visit the area every year to see its natural attractions. Belonging to the Fifth Congressional District comprising the towns of Barotac Viejo, San Rafael, Ajuy, Concepcion, Sara, Lemery, San Dionisio, Batad, Estancia, Balasan and Carles, it is the largest in terms of land area and second most populated in the province.

The area prides itself with island beaches that suit all tastes; from sand to gravel to rock to pebble. Most are defined by its sheer limestone cliffs, white sand beaches, and clear blue water, which attract thousands of tourists yearly. The strip of beach is accessed only by motorized pumpboat.

It is easy to see why this is Iloilo's most heavily promoted tourist hotspot. There are 55 accommodation establishments in the district including the island resorts offering 289 air-conditioned rooms and 207 fan rooms. The district ranked the biggest contributor of tourist arrivals for the province with 38.37%.

So, pack your bathing suits, your sunglasses, do not forget the sunscreen, and discover those heavenly beaches.

To get to northern Iloilo, visitors can take a bus at the Ceres Terminal in Balantang, Jaro, Iloilo City. Vans are also available at the terminal in Barangay Tagbak, Jaro, Iloilo City.




